CHAPTER 2: DELIGHT IN THE HOLY ONE

“Take delight in the LORD” (Psalm 37:4).

God graciously gives us holy moments. They are opportunities to partner with Him for His purposes. What a privilege! In our busy lives, something we may see as an interruption may be God's divine intervention. We must focus on being available for God to use us, even in ordinary, mundane activities.

Question: Are you simply relying on your ability to be of service to God? How can you be more available to serve Him in the midst of your everyday life?

Proverbs 15:8b says, “The prayer of the upright is His delight.” Psalms 1:2 says, “But his delight is in the law of the LORD, and in His law he meditates day and night.” God delights in our prayers and our reading of the Bible.

Question: In what ways have you experienced God's response to your prayers and Bible meditation?

God not only delights in our prayers and meditation on the Word, but the Bible tells us that God delights in many things.

Question: Look at the list below. In which of these attributes do you take great delight? If your friends or loved ones were to describe your character, would they choose any of the words from this list? Which attribute describes you the least? Think of new ways to integrate these godly characteristics into your life.

- **Fear of the Lord:** “The LORD delights in those who fear Him, who put their hope in His unfailing love” (Psalms 147:11, NIV).
- **Truth:** “The LORD...delights in people who are trustworthy” (Proverbs 12:22, NIV).
- **Honesty:** “The LORD...delights in honesty” (Proverbs 11:1, NLT).
- **Integrity:** “The LORD...delights in those with integrity” (Proverbs 11:20, NLT).
- **Judgment:** “‘I am the LORD, exercising... judgment...in the earth. For in [this] I delight,’ says the LORD” (Jeremiah 9:24).
- **Righteousness:** “‘I am the LORD, exercising...righteousness in the earth. For in [this] I delight,’ says the LORD” (Jeremiah 9:24).

The very best holy moment you will ever encounter is the one where you enter into God’s family by repenting of sin and giving your life to Jesus.

Question: Have you experienced the gift of salvation? If not, ask your discussion group leader to help you do that right now. There’s no better time than today to experience the best holy moment.
