CHAPTER 1: DEFINING HOLY MOMENTS

“God’s invisible qualities—His eternal power and divine nature—have been clearly seen” (Romans 1:20, NIV).

A holy moment is a supernatural surprise orchestrated by our loving Savior. Holy moments are God’s way of letting His children know that He’s there, He cares for us, and He hears our prayers.

Holy moments occur when we discover signs of the miraculous in the midst of the mundane, as God transforms our ordinary circumstances into extraordinary outcomes.

Holy: a term that refers to persons, places, or things that are set apart or separated for God’s special purpose. Anyone or anything, any place or any time set apart for God becomes holy.

Moment: a portion of time or point in time.

Holy moments offer us a glimpse of God; they are His way of making Himself known. They introduce us to the different aspects of His unique personality.

“Draw near to God and He will draw near to you” (James 4:8).

Other terms for holy moments:

- **Providence:** Providence is God incognito, a situation in which He leaves His fingerprints without revealing His hand.
- **Epiphany:** When you see something you’ve never seen before or discover a truth that unlocks an unsolved mystery.

Believing that fate has dealt you a good or bad hand denies God’s hand of providence in your life. God orchestrates circumstances that are favorable or unfavorable, according to His will for us.
